

Targets 2006/2007 - Ambulance and PCT Reorganisation Data Issues

Background and summary

In 2006, the NHS underwent a significant reorganisation of the number of ambulance trusts and primary care trusts (PCTs) in England; NHS ambulance trusts in England merged to create a total of only 12 and the number of PCTs in England was reduced to 152.

For the purposes of the 2006/2007 annual health check, the Healthcare Commission is using data for a number of existing and new national target performance indicators that encompasses the period prior to the trust reorganisations.

The purpose of this paper is to detail the Healthcare Commission's approach with regards to managing existing and new national target performance data relating to the period prior to the trust reorganisations.

Ambulance trusts

On the 1st July 2006, the number of NHS ambulance trusts in England was reduced from 30 to 12 trusts. This was brought about by nearly all the existing ambulance trusts merging with neighbouring ambulance trusts (the only exception being London Ambulance Service NHS Trust). During the reorganisation process, however, two former ambulance trusts split and joined separate ambulance trust configurations. The two former ambulance trusts in question (and the new ambulance trusts they separated to) are as follows:

Tees East and North Yorkshire Ambulance Service NHS Trust

- Yorkshire Ambulance Service NHS Trust
- North East Ambulance Service NHS Trust

Two Shires Ambulance NHS Trust

- East Midlands Ambulance Service NHS Trust
- South Central Ambulance Service NHS Trust

In the 2006/2007 annual health check, three existing national target performance indicators are using ambulance performance data relating to the period prior to the 1st July 2006, therefore requiring reconfiguration in line with the ambulance reorganisations. They are the indicators 'Category A calls meeting eight minute target', 'Category A calls meeting 19 minute target' and 'Category B calls meeting 19 minute target', which all measure KA34 ambulance service data for the full 2006/2007 financial year.

The KA34 ambulance service data for the period April to June 2006 will be aggregated in line with the ambulance reorganisations (where applicable). The allocation of performance for the period April to June 2006 for the above trusts that split is listed below. It has been agreed by the ambulance trusts themselves and their respective SHAs and is the method by which the NHS Information Centre will collate KA34 ambulance service data for these trusts.

Tees East and North Yorkshire Ambulance Service NHS Trust

- 70% to Yorkshire Ambulance Service NHS Trust
- 30% to North East Ambulance Service NHS Trust

Two Shires Ambulance NHS Trust

- 50% to East Midlands Ambulance Service NHS Trust
- 50% to South Central Ambulance Service NHS Trust

Primary Care trusts

On the 1st October 2006, the number of NHS PCTs in England was reduced from 303 to 152. This was brought about by a large number of the existing PCTs merging with neighbouring PCTs. During the reorganisation process, however, five former PCTs split and joined separate PCT configurations. The five former PCTs in question (and the new PCTs they separated to) are as follows:

In the 2006/2007 annual health check, there are a number of existing and new national target performance indicators that are using PCT performance data relating to the period prior to the 1st October 2006, therefore requiring reconfiguration in line with the PCT reorganisations. They are:

Existing National Targets:

- Access to a GP
- Access to a primary care professional
- All cancers: one month diagnosis (decision to treat) to treatment
- All cancers: two month GP urgent referral to treatment
- All cancers: two week wait
- Convenience and choice - PCT booking
- Convenience and choice - PCT facilities in place to support choice
- Delayed transfers of care
- Number of inpatients waiting longer than the standard
- Number of outpatients waiting longer than the standard
- Patients waiting longer than three months for revascularisation
- Practice based registers - patients called for review

New National Targets:

- Breast cancer screening for women aged 50 to 70 years
- Childhood obesity: data quality
- Four-week smoking quitters
- Waiting times for diagnostic tests

The PCT performance data for the period April to September 2006 will be aggregated in line with the PCT reorganisations (where applicable). The allocation of performance for the period April to September 2006 for the above PCTs that split is listed below. It includes a set of agreed population-based percentage splits for the PCTs that separated, which were developed by the Department of Health when realigning the PCT local delivery plans (LDPs) following the PCT reorganisations. They have been agreed between the Department of Health, the PCTs themselves and their respective SHAs (LDP data leads). They have also subsequently already been used for a number of data sets across the Department of Health, including local delivery plan returns (LDPR) and monthly reporting data. It is our intention to remain consistent with these agreed population-based percentage splits for the above performance indicators where possible.

- 76.8% remains Middlesbrough Primary Care Trust

Morecambe Bay Primary Care Trust

- 56.4% to Cumbria Primary Care Trust

- 90.6% to Central Lancashire Primary Care Trust

South Peterborough Primary Care Trust

- 36.4% to Cambridgeshire Primary Care Trust
- 49.4% to Peterborough Primary Care Trust
- 14.2% to Northamptonshire Teaching Primary Care Trust

Cherwell Vale Primary Care Trust

- 78.1% to Oxfordshire Primary Care Trust
- 21.9% to Northamptonshire Teaching Primary Care Trust
